## Education Department

The Urban League's Education Department motivates the intellectual and imaginative capacity of each child in a safe and nurturing environment. Through the Comcast sponsored *1000 Hours of Reading* program students across the Seattle Public District receive reading support and free books as an incentive to continue their reading at home. As a *Supplemental Educational Services* provider designated by the Federal *No Child Left Behind* program, ULMS provides high-quality, research-based tutoring and other supplemental academic enrichment services for K-8th grade youth from six designated Title I schools in Seattle.

The *Children's University* after-school program provides daily homework support, reading tutors and culturally-linked arts and humanities experiences. The summer session of Children's University provides a unique full-day integrated learning experience for k-8<sup>th</sup> grade students at the University of Washington, and is comprised of core academic studies, fine arts and literature, languages, performing arts and junior internships in architecture, mock trial, sailing and film.

Area youth can prepare for their post-high school careers by participating in ULMS programs for teenagers. *M.A.N. Up!* is an academic and social mentoring program for 8<sup>th</sup> grade males that supports successful transitions into high school. *Project M.I.S.T.E.R.* is a school-based life skills, mentoring, and intervention program. The *Urban League Scholars* program provides academic guidance, leadership activities and college readiness support at Garfield High School for 120 African and African-American students in grades 9-12. By combining academic guidance during the day, structured group study sessions and career exploration activities after-school, the League has fostered a 100% college acceptance rate among the League Scholar participants.

## **Housing**

The Urban League Housing Department's overarching goal is to assist families of low-to-moderate incomes develop money management skills to achieve the ultimate goal of homeownership. With the proper financial education, clients are able to establish long term financial independence and achieve their long and short term goals.

This Fiscal year ULMS-Housing found itself assisting families through the mortgage foreclosure crisis retain homeownership. Through grants from the City of Seattle and BECU, we were able to provide financial assistance to families (80% and below the AMI). These grants enable families to avoid foreclosure and provide adequate time for loan restructuring assistance. Additionally, ULMS Housing provides the following:

- Ready to Rent workshops for homeless or transitional housing clients
- Financial education workshops
- Homebuyer seminars that include access to down payment assistance
- Landlord/tenant counseling and advocacy
- Mortgage Intervention counseling with access to financial assistance
- Mortgage Modification sessions
- Mortgage Refinancing sessions
- Real Estate Professional Training

During the 08-09 fiscal year ULMS Housing has served 1,899 families.

## **Employment**

The Urban League's Employment Department provides employment services to employers and job seekers through a one-stop service delivery system. The job resource center assists job seekers through on-line job skills training, job counseling and case management, access to computers for job searching, assistance with resume and cover letter development, job readiness workshops and interview technique workshops.

The Employment Department forges new alliances with partner corporations through the Corporate Partnership Initiative. Area corporations attend employment orientation workshops to meet clients, discuss job openings, and often to set up job interviews.

ULMS helps young adults gain important job skills through its Youth Employment Program. Building upon individual, family, and community strengths, these individualized programs are designed to engage youth by enhancing their opportunities, ultimately supporting their growth into capable, responsible, and caring citizens.

## **Youth Development Initiatives**

Another Way Out Street Outreach Program and the Central Area Network hub are major components of the Seattle Youth Violence Prevention Initiative (SYVPI). The primary focus of the Another Way Out is to outreach to the most at-risk, often court involved youth and connect them to community prevention, intervention and re-entry services such as case management, housing, mental health and drug/alcohol treatment, employment and job training, aggression replacement training (A.R.T.), and various other services provided by grassroots community-based organizations. The primary focus population of the initiative are youth who: (1) have been convicted of repeat offenses for violence incidents; (2) have been arrested, but not detained; (3) are middle school students at-risk of suspension or are truant; or (4) are victims of violence and their associates.

The Central Area Network hub is responsible for coordinating services internally and externally funded through SYVPI. The network hub approach is designed to ensure services and community resources are used in the most appropriate manner to meet the unique needs of SYVPI youth through collaboration with government agencies, organizations and the overall community.

## **Contractor Development & Competitiveness Center**

The ULMS Contractor Development and Competitiveness Center (CDCC) builds and implements innovative strategies for entrepreneurial development. The ULMS-CDCC consults to both public agencies and corporations to maximize the inclusion of small, minority, women-owned, and disadvantaged business enterprises in their contracting opportunities. In one instance, our efforts assisted in the execution of over \$15 million in contracts amongst eight (8) ULMS-CDCC member firms over a six-month span in 2009 with a public agency. These successes promulgate business growth and the creation of hundreds of family-livable wage jobs. Small business is often referred to as “*the fabric of our economy*”. The ULMS-CDCC is partnering with over thirty (30) organizations to strengthen that fabric through “***Pathways for Small Business***”. ***Pathways*** serves entrepreneurs through the timely provision of resources, technical assistance, and tailored coaching. The target future is a strong and sustainable economy through high-performance small businesses.
