## **Counseling Set For Home Buyers with Disabilities**

The Urban League of Metropolitan Seattle sponsors counseling for people with a disability that would like to take advantage of the HomeChoice loan program. This counseling is part of the Urban Leagues Hope for Homes Project.

The counseling is designed to show renters how they can afford to buy a home using available down payment assistance programs.

HomeChoice is a downpayment assistance program for low-to-moderate income people with a disability or who have a family member with a disability living with them and qualify for a conventional mortgage loan using HomeChoice guidelines. The maximum amount of funds available is \$15,000. One on One housing counseling is a requirement.

At the completion of the hour counseling session, Urban League will issue a Certificate of completion.
